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### Guidelines for Practicing the Following Studies

1. Use a metronome and tonic drone whenever possible.
2. Each major and minor key includes eight exercises, plus several chromatic exercises at the end of the book. Although a suggested tempo range is included, only perform each exercise as fast as you can play accurately.
  1. Basic Pattern, One Octave: ♩=120+
  2. One Octave in Thirds: ♩=92+
  3. One Octave in Fourths: ♩=92+
  4. Diatonic Arpeggios: ♩=104+
  5. Revolving, Part 1: ♩=72+
  6. Interval/Flow Study: ♩=72 or slower
  7. Basic Pattern, Two Octaves: ♩=88+
  8. Revolving, Part 2: ♩=72+
  9. Chromatic: ♩=120-as fast as possible
3. Pencil in accidental and fingering reminders as necessary, but not to excess. Avoid writing in note names, especially when learning to read bass clef.
4. Strive for a uniform mezzo-forte to forte dynamic across the entire range, with full note values. For variety, practice with different combinations of dynamics and articulations.
5. The ultimate goal is to commit to memory as many patterns as possible. A suggested study guide with period quizzes is included.
